The training programs are designed for Christians who want to strengthen their understanding of the scriptures and Christian service as well as provide a greater support to their local churches.

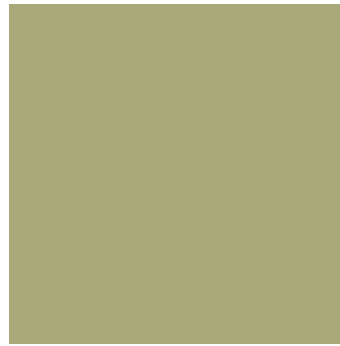
Bible Institute offering Certificate Level programs
